Ensure that the number and complexity of questions are appropriate for the allotted exam time.

6. Reviewing and Revising the Exam Paper:

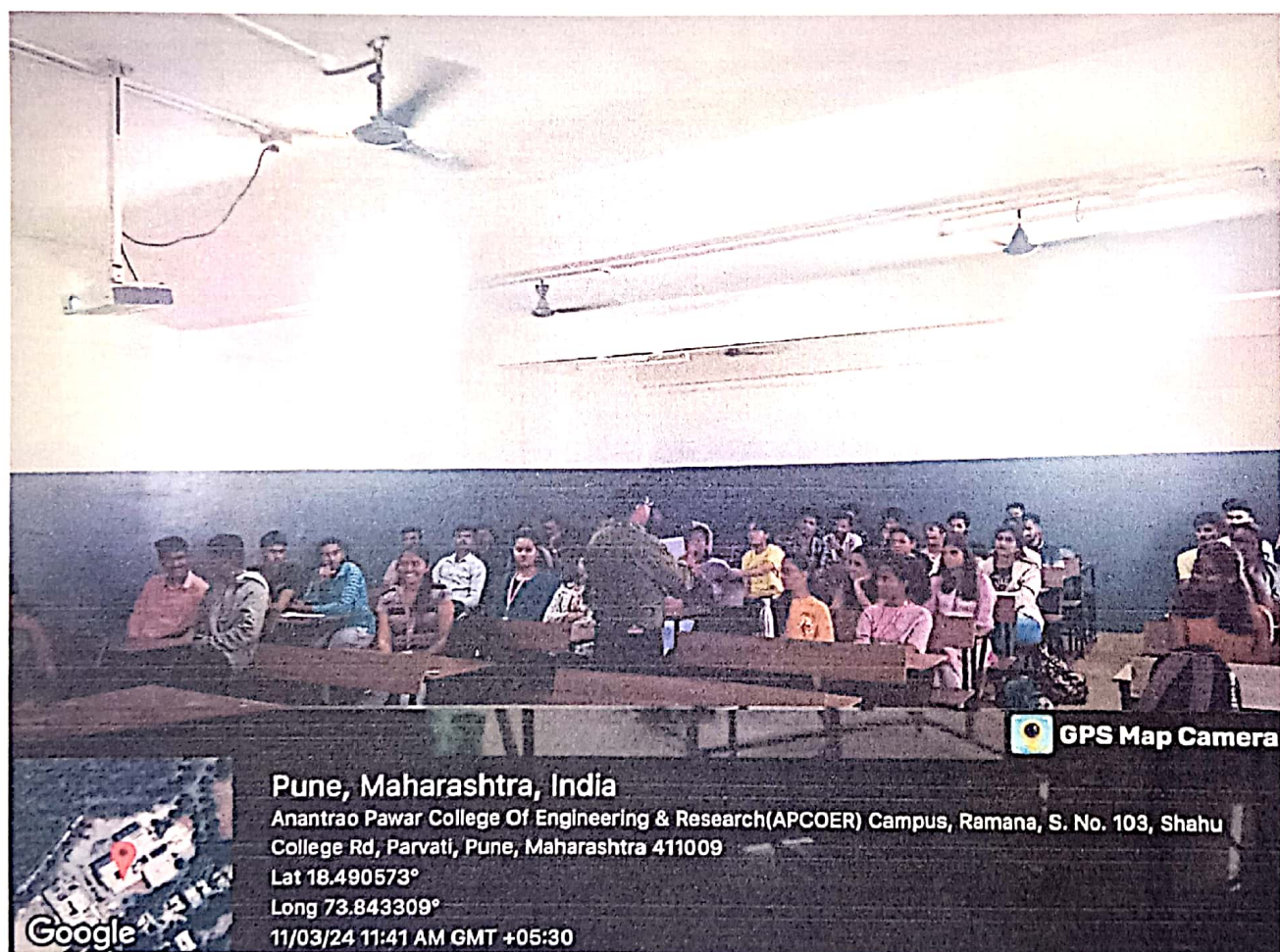
- Advised instructors to thoroughly proofread the exam paper for errors in grammar, spelling, and formatting.
- Suggested conducting trial runs with colleagues or students to gather feedback and make necessary revisions.
